Seventh Sunday of the Resurrection

الأحد السابع من زمن القيامة

يعرضُ لنا الإنجيل "وحدة المجد" القائمة بين الآب والإبن. الإبن عاش ليمجد الآب، وقد مجده حتى أَنه قَبِلَ بالموت طوعاً على خشبة العار، من أجل إتمام مشيئته. وها هو يسوع يصرخ اليوم بأعلى صوته أَن الإبن قد تمجد، أي أَن الله الآب مجده بالقيامة الظاهرة من بين الأموات. أرسل الله الآب إبنه الوحيد من أجل خلاصنا ومن أجل تحريرنا من عبودية الخطيئة والموت. فما من حُب أعظم من أن يُعطي الإنسان نفسه فداءً عن أحبائه. يسكب علينا الرب يسوع وصيته الوحيدة: الحبة: بما ندخل إلى جوهر قلب الله الذي هو الحبة بكما لها. هذا الحَب هو مثال التالوث على الأرض، هو حضور إلهي متمثل بالإخوة. نحن ندخل في عمق "الشراكة التالوثية": فالآب يمجّد ابنه الوحيد، ويسوع يُجيب أباه بأن يمجده بالطاعة له حتى الصليب. وتأتي الحلقة الثانية بأن يمجّد يسوع جميع تلاميذه والمؤمنين به فيهمهم الخلاص بقيامته. والمؤمنون يمجّدون اسم يسوع بأن يقبلونه كمخلصهم الوحيد. ولكن يسوع يضع لنا، اليوم، حلقة ثالثة، عبر وصيته الجديدة: المسيحي يمجّد يسوع بأن يُحِب أخاه كما أحبّه يسوع. والأخ المحبوب يمجّد يسوع بأن يجعل هذا الحَب الذي تلقاه من أخيه شهادة حية صادقة ليسوع، شهادة صارخة أمام سائر الأمم.

Gospel: John 13: 31 - 35

Reading: Ephesians 1: 15 - 23

The Gospel shows us the united glory between Jesus and His Father. Jesus gave His Father supreme honor and glory through His obedience and willingness to sacrifice His life on the cross. The Father brings glory to the Son through the Resurrection. God, our Father, gave us His only begotten Son for our sake, to redeem us from slavery to sin and death. There is no greater proof of God's love for us than the Cross of Jesus Christ. Love is Jesus' only commandment to us. Through love we will have access to God's heart, which is the perfection of Love. Love represents the trinity on earth: The Father glorifies the Son; the Son glorifies the Father through His obedience until the crucifixion. Then the Son glorifies His disciples and His followers giving them salvation through the Resurrection. The followers glorify Jesus by accepting Him as their only Saviour. Today, Jesus adds a third series through his new commandment: The Christians glorify Jesus by loving their brothers the same way they were loved by Jesus. We glorify Jesus by making the love given to us, a living testimony of Jesus to the world.
