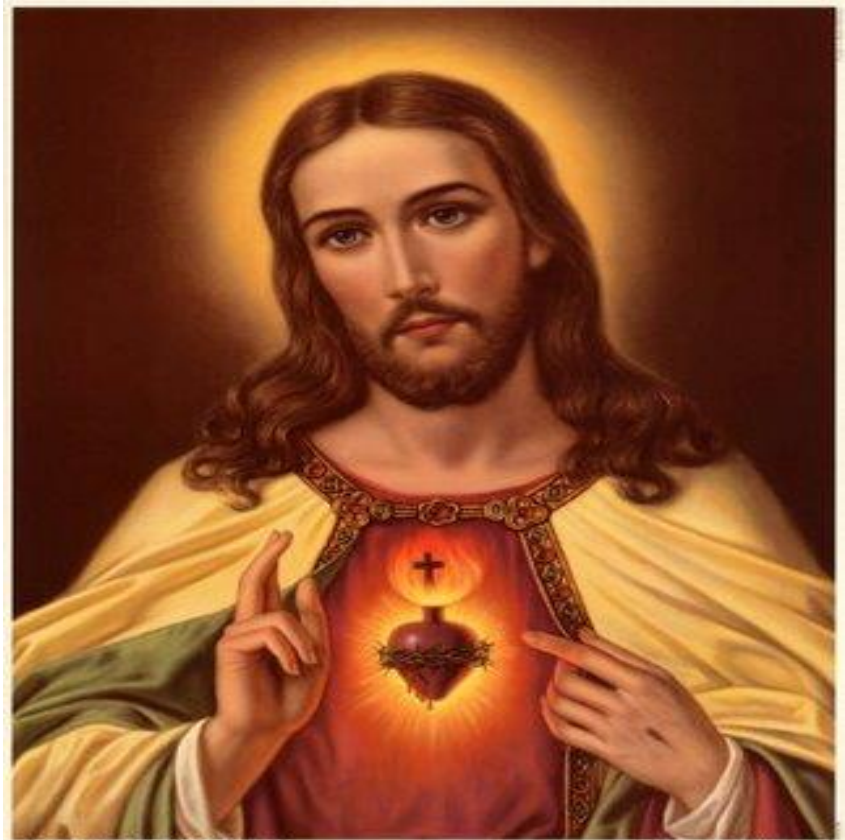
### **Our Parish Mission Statement**

**Third Sunday of the Pentecost**

**الأحد الثالث من زمن العنصرة**

في الأحد الثالث من زمن العنصرة، تدعونا الكنيسة المارونية إلى التأمل بسرّ الحبة الذي يتجلى في حفظ الوصايا وتتميم إرادة الله. في إنجيل اليوم يُعلن الربّ للتلاميذ إنهم قادرين على معاينة الله، لأنّ الربّ ذاته يُظهر لهم نفسه. شرط المعاينة ليس الرغبة في المعرفة أو اللمس والفهم، بل إنّ الشرط الوحيد هو الدخول في علاقة حبّ مع الربّ. يظهر الاختلاف بين المنطق البشريّ والمنطق الإلهي: الإنسان يطلب أن يرى ليؤمن، والربّ يطلب الإيمان لإظهار ذاته. الإيمان هو عمل محبة لا معرفة عقلية. لماذا نحن لا العالم؟ يسأل يهوذا. كلمات تظهر الرغبة في خلاص العالم كلّهُ، التي ينبغي على التلميذ التحلّي بها. أن أكون تلميذاً للمسيح يعني ان أكون متشوّفاً لخلاص الكون كلّهُ، فَمَن يلمس رغبة المسيح وحبّه لا يمكنه أن يكون أنانياً أو غير مهتمّ بخلاص إخوته. دعانا الربّ يسوع واختارنا لنحمل بشارته للعالم. إنّ سلام الربّ يُرافق كنيسته المنطلقة إلى مجتمع يرفضها ويضطهدها لأنّها تُعلن قيم الربّ وترزع في العالم ثمار الروح القدس.

**Gospel: John 14: 21 - 27**

**Reading: Corinthians 2: 1 – 10**

On the Third Sunday of the Pentecost, the Church invites us to contemplate on the mystery of love which embodies the keeping the Commandment of the Lord. In this Gospel, Jesus proclaims to the disciples that they are able to see God, because God wishes to reveal Himself to them. The only way to see God is by loving Him without doubt. The difference appears between the logic of God and that of humans. Human beings need to see before they believe; however, God reveals Himself through faith. Faith is act of love from the heart without the need of knowledge and fact. Judas (not Iscariot) asks, "How is it that you will reveal yourself to us, and not to the world?" These words show the desire of saving the whole world. Every disciple should have this desire. To be one of Jesus' disciples, we should be anxious to save the world. Whoever touches the passion and love of Christ cannot be selfish and inconsiderate towards his brothers' salvation. Jesus chose us to carry His salvation to the world. The peace of God is with His Church who, at times, is denied and persecuted by society. The Church proclaims the Word of God by planting the fruits of the Holy Spirit in the world.
