Ninth Sunday of the Pentecost

الأحد التاسع من زمن العنصرة

أطلق يسوع رسالته من خلال ليتورجيا السبت، وهي تقليد مقدّس، فهو إذاً مُتمّم الوعود كلّها. بدأ رسالته في الجليل حيث ترعرع، لكنّه أوصى تلاميذه بحمل البشارة إلى أقاصي الأرض. إختار قراءة النبيّ أشعيا التي تُعلن عن الدور الذي سيّقوم به المسيح المنتظر. لقد تنبأ النبيّ أشعيا أن المسيح سيأتي بقوة الروح القدس ليطلق المقهورين أحراراً من الخطيئة (أشعيا ٦١: ١-٢). وهنا يُعلن يسوع أنّ به ومعه تمّت هذه النبوءة، بل يُشدّد أنّ النبوءات لم تُعدّ وعوداً للمستقبل، بل إنّها تحققت اليوم. إنّ بشرى يسوع وكلماته تهب الحرية لمن له أذنان سامعتان. مع يسوع صار وعد الله حقيقة، والكتب صارت إنجيلاً. إن كان اليوم يوم الخلاص، وإن كانت كلمة يسوع يجب أن تتم، فهذا يعني أنّه علينا أن نكون كالمؤمنين الذين زارهم يسوع، نتلقّى كلامه بشغف ونقدم له سلاسل قلوبنا، وكل ما يشلُّ محبتنا في حياتنا اليومية. نحن نبحت كالعبيان في صلاتنا وخدمتنا، لكنّ يسوع القائم من الموت، يُبرر عيون قلبنا ويُعطينا روحه القدّوس.

Gospel: Luke 4: 14 - 21

Reading: 2 Corinthians 5: 20 - 21, 6: 1 - 10

Jesus began His mission through the Liturgy of Saturday, in His own land of Galilee where He was reared. His proclamation of the fulfillment of the Messianic prophecy of Isaiah brought wonder to His kin. Isaiah had prophesied that the Messiah would come in the power of the Holy Spirit to bring freedom to those oppressed by sin and evil (Isaiah 61:1-2). Through Jesus, we see the grace of God in action. His gracious words brought hope, joy, and favor to those who were ready to receive Him. With Jesus, the promises of God are fulfilled. He came to set us free from the worst tyranny possible, slavery to sin, fear of death and the eternal destruction of both body and soul. If today is the day of salvation and Jesus words must be fulfilled; we would have to be like the faithful that Jesus visited. We should listen attentively to Jesus' words and offer Him the chains of our hearts, giving up all animosity and hatred. We are blindly searching in our prayers and services but Jesus, the risen from the dead, will enlighten the eyes of our hearts and gives us His Holy Spirit.
