Eleventh Sunday of the Pentecost

الأحد الحادي عشر من زمن العنصرة

حين نقرأ إنجيل لوقا الذي يُشدّد على وجوه الوثنيين في الكنيسة مع اليهود، نفهم لماذا وردّ خير زكّا العشار. زكّا هو رئيس العشارين غنيّ وهو بالتالي شخصٌ منبوذ من الجماعة، لأنّه يجمع الضرائب ويضع في جيبه بقدر ما يدفع للدولة. وخصوصاً لأنّه يتعامل مع روما المسيطرة على أرض الرّب. ومع ذلك مضى يسوع إلى زكّا وما اكتفى بزيارة، بل أقام عنده وأعلن له الخلاص. أراد زكّا رؤية يسوع، فتوقّف يسوع. لم يمرّ أمام رغبة زكّا دون أن يُعيّره إنتباهه. عرف زكّا أنّه مُهمّ في عين الرّب فانفتح. خرج من قوقعة المال والجاه والسلطة، إلى فرح الإستسلام لعناية الرّب من خلال محبة الإخوة. نرى عمق تويّبه عندما قرّر أن يعطي نصف ثروته للفقراء والنصف الآخر لتغطية عمليات الإختلاس التي أقام بها. أحبّه الرّب فعرف أنّه قادر على المحبة. هكذا دخل الخلاص إلى بيته وحياته. نعم، لقد جاء الرّب ليُزور الخلاص كلّ بيت.

Gospel: Luke 19: 1 - 10

Reading: Ephesians 2: 17 - 22

Upon reading the Gospel of Saint Luke, which focuses on the presence of the pagan in the Church with the Jews, we understand why Zacchaeus was mentioned as an isolated person in the society. Zacchaeus, the tax collector! Tax collectors were despised and treated as outcasts, no doubt because they accumulated great wealth at the expense of others. Zacchaeus was a chief tax collector and was much hated by all the people but mostly because he was dealing with Rome which was governing the land of the Lord. Jesus not only visited Zacchaeus but he stayed with him and gave him the good news. Zacchaeus needed God's merciful love and in his encounter with Jesus he found more than he imagined possible. He shows the depth of his repentance by deciding to give half of his goods to the poor and to use the other half for making restitution for fraud. Zacchaeus' testimony included more than words, his change of heart resulted in a change of life. The lord came so the salvation dwells in each home.
