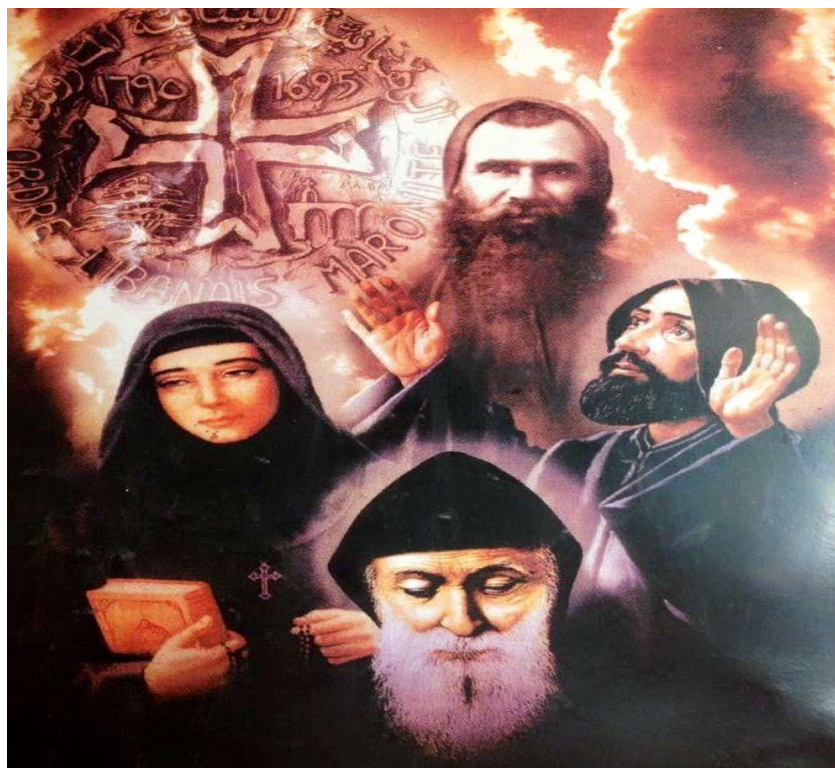

أحد الأبرار والصدّيقين

في أحد الأبرار والصدّيقين، نقف مذهولين أمام ازداوجيّة ظاهريّة بين الحبّة والدينونة. يبدأ الذهول برؤية ابن الإنسان جالساً على عرش أبيه، ونحن الذين اعتدنا على تواضعه وانسحاقه، نقف في صفّ الآتين إليه، وليس أماننا سوى خيارين: "إمّا أن نكون من مُباركي الآب، وإمّا من المّلاعين". مَشْهَدٌ رهيب لا يرغب أحدٌ منّا تخيله. وتأتي مقاييس التميّيز لتنتشلنا من خوفنا. فالملكوت مُعدٌّ لمن أطعم الإخوة. وهكذا يتجلّى لنا أنّ الحكم ليس حُكم السيّد علينا، ولكنّه بالحقيقة حُكمنا على أنفسنا. يأتي الملك في يوم لا نعلمه وفي ساعة لا نتوقّعها ليُدين الأحياء والأموات. وهذا الملك الدّيّان هو الرّاعي الذي يُميّز الخراف عن الجداء وهو أيضاً الجائع، العطشان، الغريب، العريان، المريض، والخبوس... موقفنا من هؤلاء هو موقفنا من يسوع. يؤكّد يسوع أنّه حاضر مُتجسّب فيهم كما هو حاضر مُتجسّباً في الخبز والخمر. لن ننتظر آخر الزمن حتّى نلتقيه، إنّه يأتي إلينا في كلّ لحظة. فهلّموا إلى خدمته في الجائع، العطشان، الغريب... لكي يكون الملكوت مُهيّأ لنا.

Gospel: Matthew 25:31-46

Reading: Hebrews 12: 18 - 24

On the Sunday of the Righteous and the Just, we find ourselves facing a dual challenge between love and judgment. We see the Son of Man, who is humble and loving, sitting on His Father's throne, and we are coming towards him with two choices: "Either we are blessed by the Father or cursed." A horrible spectacle no one wishes to imagine. The estimating separation will calm our fear. The kingdom of God is prepared for whoever showed true compassion and mercy toward their neighbour. Then it will become clear to us that the Last Judgment will be defined by our way of living. The king will come unexpectedly to judge the living and the dead. The king-judge is the shepherd who separates the goats from the sheep; He is also the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, the sick and the prisoner... our attitude towards those will reflect the same way toward Jesus. Jesus confirms that He is present in each one of them just like His presence in the Eucharist. We don't have to wait until the end of the days to meet him, because He comes to us in each moment. Let us serve Him through the hungry, the thirsty, and the stranger... to inherit the heavenly kingdom.
