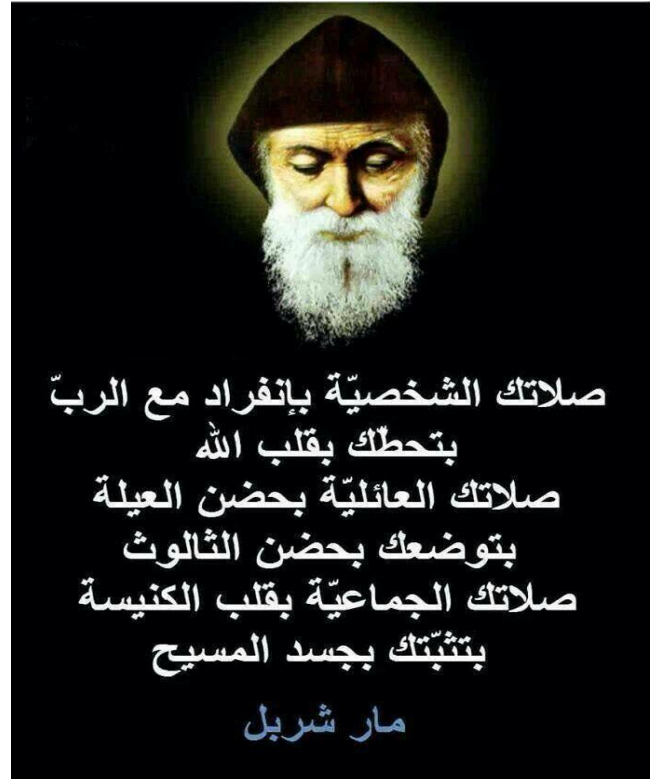

Gospel: Luke 24: 13 - 35

Reading: 2 Timothy 2: 8 - 13

On the third Sunday of the Resurrection, Saint Paul encourages his disciple Timothy to be strong and patient when faced with obstacles, because the Lord is present and loyal. The Gospel of Saint Luke invites us to open our hearts to the words of God so we can see His glory and we could be witnesses to His Resurrection. Jesus took the initiative and walked with the two disciples from Emmaus who were confused and in doubt. Jesus did not announce His name, He was gradually preparing them. The Lord reflects His will gently, giving us the freedom of choice and respecting the personal journey of each individual. The two disciples disagree as brothers, they argued to find the truth but they still walked together as brothers and children of one Holy Father. There is no place for hatred in their hearts. The two disciples did not recognize the risen Jesus until He had broken bread with them, offering His heart again. Jesus the Risen Lord is present with us in the Bread of Life and the Word of Life and Salvation.
